From The Pastor



Dear Brothers in Sisters in Christ,

I hope that you and your families have had a wonderful summer. As I write my CHIPS article for this month, I've come to realize that summer is over. I know in the Schultz back to school is what's happening. Yesterday, Annie was getting the kids supplies ready, pencils, notebooks, folders, markers, all the stuff they need for the school year. Back to school is an exciting time.

It's also a wonderful and exciting time in the life of St. Luke. September sort of starts a new ministry year. We go back to our normal worship times. Sunday School and confirmation begin for our children and teens. The elders, trustees, and church council come back together after a summer break. We even start CHIPS back up again. And while it is an exciting time in the life of the church, it's also a stressful time for your pastor, because I need help.

Beloved in Christ, we are facing a problem at St. Luke. Right now, we don't have enough Sunday School help to have Sunday School every week. Positions on church council and trustees are unfilled, and we have several people going off in December. And as your pastor, I feel it's important that I'm honest with you: This is a problem.

So, what are we to do? The first thing is that we as a church need is to be in prayer together, praying that God helps us identify and equip leaders. Next, I ask you to search your own heart. Are you willing to step up? Are you willing to say yes if God calls you? Often, we make excuses about why we can't. And the truth is, that's nothing new. When you read through the pages of the Scriptures, do you know what you find? Heroes of the faith making excuses. Abraham said he was too old. Jeremiah said he was too young. Moses said he couldn't speak right. Jonah said the people of Nineveh would never listen. But, God used each them, despite their excuses, to do amazing things. And I know He can do the same thing through you. All you need to do is say yes.

So, brothers and sisters, let us all come together in prayer. Let's pray for our ministries and leadership teams, pray for our leaders, pray that God gives us people willing to step up, and ask God what He wants from you. When we do this, I know that God will do amazing things for and through us.
